MINUTES OF THE MULBERRY GAP ASSOCIATION OF UNITED BAPTISTS 1838 – 1859

The minutes book of the Mulberry Gap Association of United Baptists from 1838 through 1859 was found many years ago. It is in terrible, incomplete, and much abused condition.

We have scanned what is still left of the pages in this mid-nine-teenth century church record. Because the pages are not numbered, we don't know exactly how many pages have been removed by vandalism, accident, or mishandling by persons who had it in their possession before we obtained it. Some pages have heavy damage, corners torn off, and stains from non-archival cellophane tape repairs.

In spite of the pitiful condition of the book, it still contains a lot of interesting and historical information that can be of value to readers, historians and/or genealogists researching the early history of the Mulberry Gap Association of United Baptists.




